### **YEAR 5 BLACK COUNTRY MUSEUM VISIT - Friday 16<sup>th</sup> November 2018**

As part of our 'Victorians' unit this autumn term, the pupils will be studying the lives of Victorian children. This year we have planned a visit to The Black Country Museum to further their learning and inspire their writing.

The day includes a tour around the museum and extra sessions led by museum staff, including the underground mine tour and a Victorian classroom workshop. This is an interesting and educational experience as well as lots of fun for the children.

In order to be able to run the trip, we are asking for a contribution of **£14.50**, which can be paid via Joinos or via cash or cheque. This is the only paid-for trip for Year 5 this year, the full cost of the trip is higher than this, but will be subsidised by the school. If you have not activated your Joinos account for some reason and require another code, please contact the School Office.

*If your child is in receipt of a Free School Meal, or has been at any time in the past six years, or has been adopted from care, then the cost of this particular trip will be met through our Pupil Premium funding, providing they meet the attendance criteria.*

The children should wear normal school uniform, but **must** bring a waterproof coat and hat and wear suitable shoes as we will be walking between sites and not all areas are located indoors. **A packed lunch (NO fizzy or canned drinks allowed) will be needed, even if your child has a school lunch, as school lunches do not arrive until later in the morning.**

The bus will be leaving school at **8:30am sharp**. Anyone who is not in school by **8:20am** will miss the bus. The bus returns to school by **4:15pm approx**.

**Parents/carers will need to notify After-School Clubs of this time if they usually attend on a Wednesday.** Otherwise, please make arrangements to collect your child at this time outside the Year 5 classrooms. *Please mark this clearly on the reply slip.*

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure they have taken a tablet before coming to school on this day. If another tablet is needed on the return journey, please send one in an envelope clearly marked with instructions and the child's name. **In addition, if they need an inhaler/epi pen, please make sure there is an 'in date' inhaler/epi pen in school for them to take with them on the trip.**

Please complete the consent form attached and return to your child's class teacher by **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2018 at the latest.**



If you are paying by cash/cheque, please send your payment in an envelope, clearly stating child's name and class, amount enclosed and name of trip. Cheques to be made out to Delapre Primary School.
