Renewed Covid Guidelines – November 2021

You may be aware that the Department for Education has issued new guidance for schools as a response to the new Covid variant 'Omicron'.

Specifically, the update for primary schools from the guidance is as follows:

'In primary schools, we recommend that face coverings should be worn by staff and adults (including visitors) when moving around in corridors and communal areas. Health advice continues to be that children in primary schools should not be asked to wear face coverings.'

This change has been communicated to staff and is in operation now. Staff do not need to wear masks in classrooms although they can if they wish.

We would like to pause your Friday morning visits into the classrooms from this week. We will review this after Christmas.

There are no other changes that directly affect parents/carers currently.

Could we please just ask that you are mindful of social distancing when speaking to staff on the playground.
