Dear Parents/Carers

**YEAR 6 – End of School Year PLEASE READ DETAILS BELOW CAREFULLY**

As we have been unable, up to now, to see all our current Year 6 pupils in school and they have not had the opportunity to say 'goodbye' to their friends, staff or school!, we would like to invite them all to an 'end-of-school' picnic. There is very little we can do which we normally would, but at least this way we can safely 'send-off' our amazing Year 6 pupils on to the next chapter in their lives.

We would like to invite all Y6 pupils to a picnic on the field with all their classmates. We sadly cannot, due to current restrictions, invite a whole year group in at any one time – but we can invite a full class. Therefore, we will be holding these events over three days as follows:

- 6Ca** – Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July from 1:00pm – 3:00pm
- 6CI** – Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July from 1:00pm – 3:00pm
- 6F** – Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July from 1:00pm – 3:00pm

We will provide food and drink for the children, specific dietary requirements will be taken into account, but pupils may wish to bring the following items in with them on their day. *Please note: if your child is currently attending school, they will not need to bring a lunch in on their picnic day.*

If your child would like to take away a signed school shirt, by all their classmates and staff (this is an annual tradition at Delapre for Year 6 leavers), they will need to bring in a clean school yellow polo shirt – with their name clearly written on the inside of the collar. They will also need an indelible ink pen. We will have spares in case any pens run dry.

Your child will also need to bring a picnic blanket, cloth or beach towel to sit on and, if the weather is hot and sunny as predicted, please ensure your child has applied suncream and is sufficiently protected with a sun hat etc., They may also want to bring an extra drink with them.

If you wish your child to wear a medical face mask to this event, that is your choice. They must be happy to remove and replace the mask themselves and not require adult assistance. We will have plenty of hand sanitiser available on the field.

On the day, children who are not in school will enter and exit, for the picnic, by the large wooden gates in Briar Hill Road. **Unless we hear from you, we will assume your child has permission to walk home alone.** If not, parents/carers must collect from Briar Hill Road – school field entrance at 3:00pm. *Children who are already in school on the day can also leave at 3pm from that exit, unless we hear otherwise from you.*
