Dear Parents/Carers

MEASLES, CHICKEN POX AND SHINGLES

We are requesting your co-operation in an important matter.

One of our pupils is receiving medical treatment for cancer which puts them at risk if they are exposed to a number of serious illness.

Please let us know immediately if your child is suspected of having chicken pox or measles or shingles.

Please **do not** send your child to school if you suspect they have chicken pox, measles or shingles, or any other serious illness which may be infectious to others. If this pupil comes into contact with chicken pox they would need to be given an injection within three days. It is also important that you let us know if there is any other case of shingles in the household.

Your child is not at any risk whatsoever from this situation. However, the health and well-being of our pupil who "is at risk" does depend on the co-operation of all other parents/carers.
