MUDDY EDUCATION CENTRE VISIT – MONDAY 23rd MAY AND WEDNESDAY 25th MAY 2022

(Your child will only attend on one of these dates, see below)

Monday 23rd May: 1FG and half of 1PW

Wednesday 25th May: 1A and other half of 1PW

1PW parents – please see the sticker in your child's reading diary to see which date they will be attending.

To support the children's well-being and their work in Art, we have planned a trip to the Muddy Education Centre in Holdenby village on Monday 23rd and Wednesday 25th May 2022.

The children will be involved in forest school activities, making popcorn over an outdoor fire, and sculpture work using natural materials. All activities will take place outdoors, so a waterproof coat will be essential if the forecast is wet. The Muddy Education Centre does, however, have an indoor classroom if it is needed and has toilet facilities onsite.

The children should come to school dressed in **school uniform on the top half with joggers/leggings and trainers/comfortable footwear on the bottom half**. If it has been particularly wet beforehand, we would also recommend wellies in place of other footwear.

On the days of the trip, we will leave after normal registration and be back in school before the end of the school day, therefore **drop off and collection times are unchanged**. Please be prompt to school on those days to give us enough time to toilet all the children before getting on the coach.

The cost of the trip is being partly subsidised by the school. We are asking parents to contribute **£11.50** towards the cost of the entrance fee and coach. You may pay for this online via your **ParentPay account**. If your child is classed as Pupil Premium or has been adopted from care, then the cost of this visit will be met through our Pupil Premium funding, provided that your child meets our attendance criteria.

A packed lunch (no fizzy/canned drinks or glass bottles and **NO** products containing nuts) **will be needed**, even if your child has a school lunch, as school lunches do not arrive in school until later in the day.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure that they have a tablet before coming into school. If another tablet is needed before the return journey, please send one in an envelope, clearly marked with instructions and your child's name and class. Please let your child's Class Teacher know so that we can try to sit these children towards the front of the coach.

Please return the permission slip attached to your child's Class Teacher once you have paid the £11.50 trip cost, on **ParentPay**, or **alternatively send the money in with the form**. Please can we have payment and forms no later than Friday **29th April 2022**. Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough payments by this date the trip may have to be cancelled. Thank you for your continued support.
