



If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium funding, i.e. is eligible for the statutory benefit of a Free School Meal (*this is available to school-aged children from families who receive other qualifying benefits and who have been through the relevant registration process and is **NOT** the same as the Universal Infant Free School Meal to which all Reception and Key Stage One children are entitled*) or has been adopted from care, then the cost of this tuition will be met through our Pupil Premium funding. Please note that this is now subject to meeting our attendance criteria (attending school for a minimum of 96% of available sessions).

However, if you wish to cancel, but do not give 3 months' notice in writing, **you will be responsible for paying the next term's cost of £51 yourself**. In addition, books, reeds and strings are not covered by Pupil Premium funding, so there is still some financial commitment from yourselves.

By sending this email you are committing yourself to pay 3 x 11 week sessions per year at a cost of £51 per session – total of £153 for the year, unless my child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding.

You are also agreeing to give a minimum of 3 months notice in writing if your child decides they no longer wish to learn a musical instrument and that, if you do not give sufficient notice you will be responsible for paying in full the session fees – even if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium Funding. You are also agreeing to purchase relevant music books, reeds and strings as required.
