Make Yourself Heard

In danger, need the police, but can't speak?

- 1** **Dial** 999
- 2** **Listen** to the questions from the 999 operator
- 3** **Respond** by coughing or tapping the handset if you can
- 4** If prompted, **press 55**
This lets the 999 call operator know it's a genuine emergency and you'll be put through to the police.
