SATs WEEK 2018

The Year 6 SATs tests will be taking place from Monday May 14th – 17th 2018. Please make sure that no doctor, hospital or dental appointments are booked in the mornings of these dates – afternoons are fine.

We would like to point out that it is very difficult to reschedule these tests and in order for your child to take the test at a different time you would have to ensure that your child did not have access to any other children or the internet during this time.

The rules governing this are complicated and permission is not granted for anything other than illness or serious circumstances. In the case of illness, absence from school often cannot be avoided but if your child says they are feeling 'ill' on these dates, please use your judgement as to whether they are well enough to come to school. If you feel that they are able to sit the test, but you would like them to return home afterwards please do send them in and you may collect them after the test. If your child arrives after the test has started they will not be allowed to join the class, but will have to sit the test alone once the other children have finished. The rules governing this are very strict. Obviously if it is something contagious for which you have your doctor's advice, you cannot send your child. However, sometimes children may 'feel' ill to avoid tests. Please remember that your child has practised all year for these tests; they are completely ready to take them and many of them are looking forward to seeing their final results.

On the fun side, it has been our tradition since the first year we have had a Year 6, to hold a breakfast club in school every day for all pupils who would like to join us. This is free of charge and will include orange or apple juice, a pain au chocolat or chocolate biscuit and toast with butter and jam or marmite, whichever they prefer. Breakfast will start at 8.15am. Any child arriving for breakfast after 8.40am will find it has been cleared away, so if you wish your child to come, please do make sure that they arrive at the right time. Please come into school through the front door from 8.15am.
