EVENTS UNTIL THE END OF TERM – UPDATED STATUS

As you will be aware, the Prime Minister announced on Monday 14th June that we must wait until Monday 19th July to relax all Covid-19 protocols. This has implications for a range of events that we have planned to undertake at Delapre Primary School. We are able to proceed as follows:-

5 th July	Transfer Day Yr 6 Secondary visits are largely cancelled, please check with your child's new secondary school website. Yr 6 children will be expected to come into DPS if the transfer day is not happening	This will go ahead for our current classes moving up to their new classrooms, but in a different format, still to be arranged

9 th July	Summer Fair	CANCELLED
12 th July	Reports	These will be sent home with your child, as in previous years
14 th July	Circus	This can go ahead as planned with all children having the opportunity to attend the circus on site. Further details will follow shortly
15 th July	Yr 6 Leavers Disco cancelled , alternative Leavers event being organised	To be re-arranged
16 th July	End of term – finish at normal times	
3 rd Sept	Children return to school 3rd September Training days on 1 st and 2 nd September
