CLARIFICATION ON SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY – EARRINGS and NAIL VARNISH IN SCHOOL

On Health and Safety grounds, we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school.

The exceptions to this rule are stud earrings in pierced ears (small plain metal studs only*) and a watch. In the case of stud earrings, we ask the children to remove the studs during PE and games. *With younger children, it is advisable for parents to remove earrings before school on PE days.*

To clarify: *small stud earrings should be **no bigger than half a centimetre (.5 cm)** in diameter – **plain metal**, silver or gold – with no decoration i.e., coloured enamel, glass or stones for example, and no hanging element. They can be flat studs in the form of a small shape i.e. star, butterfly, heart etc., but **MUST be plain metal and small** in size.

All earrings must be removed on PE days – as above.

Per our Uniform Policy: Delapre Primary School does not allow pupils to wear make-up or nail varnish in school.

If a pupil turns up in school wearing nail varnish, we will ask parents/carers, or the pupil themselves, to remove the nail varnish that evening.

If nail varnish is not removed by the following day, as requested, we will contact parents/carers by telephone to either come in and remove it, or take their child home.
