Welcome Back

We hope that you have had a fun filled Easter break and are feeling refreshed and ready for the term ahead. Here is what we will be learning...

Maths-In Maths we are beginning to learn about multiplication and division by learning to count in 2's, 5's and 10's forwards and backwards. In fractions we will be learning about halves and quarters of objects and numbers.

Read, Write, Inc-We will continue practising our sounds and also practise lots of 'alien' made up words such as 'poil' and 'geck'. We use our Fred Fingers to sound them out.

Science- In our unit about plants, the children will learn to name the basic parts of a plant, including seeds. They will have the opportunity to plant their own seeds and to make observations of how they grow over time. Children will also learn to identify, name and describe a variety of garden and wild plants as well as evergreen and deciduous trees.

Computing- This term the children will be introduced to data and information. We will be learning that labelling, grouping, and searching are important aspects of data and information.

PE-We will be exploring 'Traditional Tales' during our dance lessons. In Outdoor PE we be developing an understanding of different ways of travelling and different types of jumps.

Art/DT- Our DT topic is all about 'Eating more fruits and vegetables'. We will be learning about eating healthily and the children will get to design and make their own healthy pizza!

RE/PSHE -We will be looking at places in Christianity in RE. In PSHE we are talking about 'Being my best'.
