**YEAR 3 WOBURN SAFARI PARK VISIT – Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2021**

On Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2021, as part of our Science topic “Animals including Humans”, the children in Year 3 will be visiting Woburn Safari Park. We will be going through the animal enclosure to see how animals move and behave in their environment. We will also have an educational session to look at animal skeletons, bones and witness the feeding of the animals. During the visit, the children will need to observe the different types of food the animals eat as part of the healthy eating element of our science topic.

In order to be able to run the trip, we are asking for a contribution of **£14.00**. This includes coach, entrance fee and an educational session.

You may pay for this trip on-line through your Parent Pay account. If you have not activated your account for Parent Pay, please contact the School Office.

\*If your child is in receipt of a Free School Meal, or has been at any time in the past six years, then the cost of this particular trip will be met, through our Pupil Premium funding. Please note that this is now subject to meeting our attendance criteria.

- *If your child is not currently on our Free School Meal list, but you think might be eligible (and therefore eligible for Pupil Premium funding), please log onto the County Council website at [www.northamptonshire.gov.uk](http://www.northamptonshire.gov.uk) . Follow the links to Schools and Education/Free School Meals – where you will find an on-line application form together with all the information you need. Alternatively, come into school and have a chat with the staff in the School Office.*

The children should wear normal school uniform, with suitable walking shoes. **All children will need a packed lunch in a bag or backpack suitable for carrying (you could use your school PE bag). Please: no fizzy, canned or glass bottled drinks. If your child normally has a Free School Meal, on this occasion they will need to bring a packed lunch to school.** The children will also need a sunhat, sun-cream and a lightweight coat in case of rain. We ask that children do not bring mobile phones, tablets, cameras or any other valuables on the trip.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The coach will leave school promptly at 9.00am, so all children should arrive at school for registration by 8.55am. We cannot wait for children who arrive late on the day. We expect to return to school by 4.30pm, depending on traffic, so please arrange to collect your child at this time outside Year 3 classrooms.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure he/she has taken a tablet before coming to school. If another tablet is necessary for the return journey, please send one in an envelope, clearly marked with instructions and the child's name.

**Please pay £14 (Parent Pay) by Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> June.**
