Delapre Primary School has been given an exciting opportunity to attend the STEAM Northants (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths) at the University of Northampton. This is a fantastic free opportunity for children to attend the university and explore the real-world application of these curriculum areas.

Information from the University of Northampton about the event is below:

The event consists of two free flow large exhibition spaces featuring scientists, engineers, artists, VR headsets, AR technology and more.

There will be several open areas/working spaces to explore around the campus and bookable shows. These shows are from MEDICAL MAVERICKS (The Human Guinea Pig Show), BIRD MAN (birds of prey – live!), SARAH COSGRIFF (scientist and science communicator) AND IMMERSIVE EXPERIENCE 3D DOMES (learning about space and the planets in the dome)! As a school we will have the chance to attend one of these shows.

On the day:

Children will arrive at school as normal in their school uniform, with their lunch in a disposable bag. No fizzy or canned drinks allowed. If your child is eligible for a school lunch please provide a lunch on this day as school lunches do not arrive until late morning.

At 9.15am we will walk to UON Waterside Campus together. Please ensure your child is wearing comfortable shoes or trainers for the walk there and back.

We will have to spend 3 hours at the various exhibits and shows and then the children will eat their own packed lunch.

The children will be back in school before the end of the day.

This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to experience these subjects, to understand their real-life applications and to attend a higher education setting, to which we hope they aspire to attend.
