**IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YEAR 2 PARENTS – SEPTEMBER 2021**

Please find some information regarding your child starting in Year 2 in September.

**For parents/carers of children going into Class 2C**

To get to the classroom for drop off, you will need to walk up the slope to the right of the School Office, via the staff vehicular access. The pathway to the classroom is quite narrow, therefore Miss Chalmers will come out into the middle of the staff car park to greet you and your child. This will also be your pick up point at the end of the day.

**For parents/carers of children going into Class 2M**

To get to the classroom for drop off, you will need to walk up the slope to the right of the School Office, via the staff vehicular access. Miss Taylor will come out of the classroom to collect your child from you. She will position herself a little further up from the bike racks. This will also be your pick up point for the end of the day.

**For parents/carers of children going into Class 2PW**

The entrance the children need to use to get to this classroom is at the top of the steps in the playground. Mrs Prigmore-Wells will be there to greet the children at the doorway of the building in the morning, so please wait with your child until your teacher, or another member of staff, is there. This will also be your pick up point for the end of the day.

**For all Year 2 Parents/Carers**

As was the case in Year 1, once a week (weather dependent), your child will take part in an outdoor P.E lesson. With this in mind, please supply a pair of plain blue or black jogging bottoms, as part of your child's P.E kit. A decision will be taken on the day of the lesson as to whether we will ask for school jumpers or cardigans to also be worn. You are welcome to also supply trainers within their kit, which would be useful, but is certainly not essential.
